The Specialist questions, set by the Pack Horse Bowling Club, scored very well for Balance but comparatively poorly for Difficulty and Entertainment. They were the hardest questions we've had in the League so far this season, but the decent Balance mark suggests that they were equally tricky for both teams.

Overall this week there was a very slight bias in favour of the teams that went "first first". Of the nine games, five were won by teams going "first first", and four went the other way.

The teams winning by going "first first" were the Ox-fford 'C', Wharfies, British Flag, Nags Head and Park Taverners.
